# **Hackney Carriage Fares 2016**

#### Purpose of the Report

To update members on the response received to the public advertisement of the proposed new taxi fares.

## Recommendations

- 1. Confirm that as no objections have been received within the 14 day statutory notice period, then the new fare rates will take effect from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.
- 2. That the Licensing Manager be asked to notify all Hackney carriage drivers and operators of the new fees and allow a period of 28 days grace from the 1<sup>st</sup> August for all vehicle fare meters to be recalibrated to the new fares.

## **Background**

Members will recall that at their meeting of the 12<sup>th</sup> April 2016, they agreed the proposal for the fare setting process and authorised the Licensing Manager to undertake the necessary public advertisement in relation to a proposed increase in taxi fares.

#### **Report Detail**

The required statutory notice was prepared and was avertised in the Western Gazette and on the Council's notice board. It appeared in the Western Gazette on the 5<sup>th</sup> May 2016, with the last date for objections being 14 days from the publication, this being the 19<sup>th</sup> May 2016. A copy of this notice is enclosed as Appendix A to this report.

No objections to the proposal have been received.

#### **Financial Implications**

None to the authority. There will be a cost to drivers and operators or recelibrating their fare meters.
