Report

Verge cutting commenced on 8th May in the following sequence:

Classification	Target Completion Date
A & Bs	8 May 2007 – 27 May 2007
Special Sites	29 May 2007 – 3 June 2007
Class 3 Roads	4 June 2007 – 1 July 2007
Class 4 Roads	2 July 2007 – 29 July 2007

A further cut of A & Bs will then take place followed by selective cutting of the Class 3 roads.

Weed killing is currently taking place and this year the operation is being shared by SSDC and the County Council.

SSDC are concentrating their efforts on the larger towns i.e. Yeovil, Wincanton, Crewkerne, Langport and Martock etc. whilst the more rural parishes and A & B road network is being attended to by the County's Service Provider.

Surface dressing continues although this year the programme has been severely affected by the bad weather, so much so that we are currently running over three weeks behind schedule.

A ditch and outfall clearance programme has been prepared and works will get underway later this year.

The routine planned maintenance operation of gully emptying and patching continue throughout the year.

Minor maintenance schemes continue to be carried out along with repairs generated by inspections carried out by a team of dedicated Safety Inspectors based at Taunton. Because of the repair response times associated with the safety inspections it is not always possible to accurately programme the minor maintenance work.
