Purpose of the Report

Background

South Somerset District Council provides significant financial support in the form of grants to other organisations, to contribute to:

- Match-funding for projects for example:
 - o Community projects, assessed under SSDC Community Grants policies
 - o Partner / agency led projects
 - Special grants programmes (e.g. business grants)
- Services provided by key partnerships and organisations
- Other innovative or feasibility work to address local needs

Area North's current financial resources include an annual grants budget and the 3 year Area Capital Programme. The Committee has also established a Small Business Grants scheme, which is reported on separately by the Community Regeneration Officer.

Grants are administered and monitored by the Area Support team, within Area Development North.
