138. Adoption of Single Equality Scheme (Agenda Item 13)

The Portfolio Holder for Health, Housing, Inclusion and Revenues and Benefits advised that the Single Equality Scheme was a statutory document which the Council were obliged to have as a policy for all staff. He drew Members attention to the Action Plan detailing the key objectives to be met by services to promote equality and diversity across the district.

The Community Cohesion Officer confirmed that full consultation with the South Somerset Disability Forum had taken place during the compilation of the document.

The Chief Executive commended the Community Cohesion Officer for her dedication in completing the document and her enthusiasm in including all staff in the consultation and action plan.
