4. Addressing local priorities in Area North – Affordable Housing - Item for Information

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Purpose of the Report

To provide an update on current programmes of work to secure increased levels of affordable homes in Area North, and to provide further information on local housing need identified within Area North.

1. Background to this report

- 1.1. Increased provision of affordable homes in South Somerset remains a high priority, as evidence by the adopted Sustainable Community Strategy, SSDC Corporate Plan and the Somerset Local Area Agreement. Many published community-led plans (eg: 'Parish Plans'), refer to the need to increase the supply of affordable homes for local people.
- 1.2. The Joint Committee endorsed the provision of affordable homes as its highest priority and SSDC Councillors have allocated £15,000 from the area reserves to specifically to support the progress of small-scale schemes, which address local housing needs in smaller villages.

2. Rural Housing Programme

- 2.1. As previously reported, a number of surveys of local housing needs have been completed in Area North, and have been used to support the development of small scale affordable housing schemes. This work is undertaken by the Community Council for Somerset via a service level agreement funded jointly by the district and county councils.
- 2.2. The SSDC corporate plan (2009) includes a commitment to support four local housing schemes per year across the district to 2012. During 2009-10 a housing needs survey and follow up support from the Rural Housing Enabler will take place in Ash.
- 2.3. Appendix A includes an update on current local projects, and includes additional planned sites for affordable housing either through market housing developments, or from the re-development and increase of existing social housing stock.

2.4. Allocations from the additional funding will be recommended by the Head of Area Development in consultation with ward members, on a scheme by scheme basis.
