<p>R Cox</p>	<p>Long Sutton Martock Road – Junction of A372/B3151 showing signs of deterioration.</p> <p>Martock Road – ‘Failing trench’ near school.</p>	<p>Will inspect and arrange repairs as necessary.</p> <p>Carriageway planned for resurfacing.</p> <p>Comment: Martock Road has not been resurfaced solely because of this trench as thought by R Cox. Numerous factors considered when selecting sites for resurfacing. (Ride quality, life of the material, drainage, scheme location, users of the route etc).</p> <p>Trench reinstatement is greater than 10 years old.</p>
<p>P Palmer</p>	<p>Ash Main Street – Drainage issues.</p> <p>Martock North Street – Sinking surface after recent resurfacing.</p>	<p>Drainage system to be investigated.</p> <p>SCC to monitor – and arrange repairs as necessary.</p>
<p>D Nelson</p>	<p>General Comment Time frame by which utility companies are responsible for their workmanship after digging up the highway.</p>	<p>Comment: Reinstatements have a 2-year maintenance period before being signed off by SCC Streetworks Inspector.</p>
