A project update will be provided on request. Should the scheme be delayed or unable to commence within twelve months from the 7. date of this committee, SSDC must be notified in writing. 8. Should the final cost be less than the estimate considered by the Committee, the funding will be proportionately reduced. However, if the cost exceeds that estimate, no further funding will normally be available. SSDC must be notified of, and approve, any proposed changes to the project. The applicant will share good practice with other organisations if successful in 10.

Grants can only be paid for a single year and a second application is not allowed for

the same project within 3 years (unless Service Level Agreement).
