Area Committees provide a key mechanism for Councillors to represent the views of their constituents and for local organizations to have their views taken into account in local decisions.

We work closely with Town and County Councils, with partnerships, organisations and individuals to help make our communities better, safer places to live in, to encourage business and trade, to help develop skills and improve the health of their citizens.
