# The Installation of Jobcentre Plus Jobpoint Kiosk and Telephone at Holyrood Lace Mill Reception – Update Report

# Background

The Chard Jobcentre Plus office closed at the end of March 2008 following an internal review. The nearest offices open to customers are now Yeovil and Taunton. Andrew Gillespie met with Jobcentre Plus managers with a view to hosting a Jobcentre Plus Jobpoint in the reception area at the Holyrood Lace Mill. This would allow free access to Jobcentre Plus advice and information including job vacancies in Chard and at no cost to the customer. It also fits well with the Community Office concept of access for the community to a large range of public services at a local venue.

### The Jobpoint explained

A Jobcentre Plus Jobpoint consists of a dedicated telephone line and an information kiosk (interactive computer terminal).

The kiosk connects customers directly to the Jobcentre Plus website. This contains a range of advice and information including job vacancies.

The dedicated telephone connects customers to the Jobcentre Plus advisors and offers many choices of service including:

- Access to a job advisor about vacancies on the website
- Making or renewing a Jobcentre Plus benefit claim
- Applying for a National Insurance number
- Tax and Pension Credit
- Connection to the Taunton and Yeovil Jobcentre Plus offices.

Jobcentre Plus staff will make occasional use of the adjacent interview room for prearranged meetings with their customers. The interview room will have an internet connection to allow Jobcentre Plus staff to access their systems during interviews.

### **Progress**

The necessary legal agreements between Jobcentre Plus and South Somerset District Council have now been completed. The reception needed some slight alteration to create a discrete and private Jobcentre Plus area. These alterations are due to be finished and the dedicated phone installed and working by 8th September. The kiosk is on order but with a long lead time, so the target installation date is October.
