# 6. Presentation from Opportunity Ilminster 2009 Winners

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#### **Purpose of Presentations**

For two years running Opportunity Ilminster was held in the town and on each occasion a number of groups and individuals applied to win a share of the money. Over the two years 24 projects were awarded funding totalling £52,494. Representatives from three of those organisations have been asked to give a short presentation to members providing an update on what benefits the funding provided.

#### Recommendation

To note and thank the representatives from the three organisations for their presentations.

#### **Horton Village Hall**

Received funds on both occasions; firstly £5,000 towards a new footpath connecting the new hall to the village. In the second year they received £2,000 to help buy new equipment for the kitchen.

#### **Ilminster Town Council – Sports Initiative**

In November 2009 Ilminster Town Council were awarded £2,000 to help kick start a project to create a new sports pavilion in the town.

## **Experience Ilminster**

In November 2008, the idea was put forward to create a new three day festival in mid June providing a wide range of activities that would bring the community together. The public liked the idea enough to vote to award Experience Ilminster £5,000. In 2009 Experience Ilminster were awarded a further £2,000 to help put on the second event.
