Purpose of the Report

To inform the Licensing Committee of the outcomes following an extensive audit of all the taxi ranks in the SSDC area.

Recommendation

That the Committee recommend that this report go to the relevant Area Committees for approval to update rank orders and explore any need for relocation of ranks as required.

Background

A comprehensive assessment of each of the ranks was carried out between March and July 2007 in conjunction with the Highways Agency. Details about the ranks, their location, length etc are as follows.

Details of all the Taxi Ranks

YEOVIL – Hendford

This taxi rank has been properly marked within the terms of the Highways Act. It is properly signposted and DDA compliant.

Action to be taken:

A full consultation was conducted with all the Licensed Hackney Carriage drivers in SSDC. We received 69 responses. Of the 69 responses 67 had not used the rank since the closure of Le Jardin (97%) and 60 out of 69 (86%) wanted the rank moved to another part of town.

The Licensing section will seek approval to look at alternative locations for these rank facilities.

YEOVIL - Stars Lane

Action to be taken:

Following incidents of crime and disorder at the taxi rank outside of The Chicago Rock Night Club the police have requested that the taxi rank be relocated to the Stars Lane Car Park. This has been trialled for a number of weeks and has found to increase taxi capacity and reduce waiting time for customers thus dispersing people from the area and reducing crime and disorder in the area. The licensing section will seek approval to further investigate the police request.

YEOVIL - Labour Club

With the proposed development of the site it may be necessary to relocate the current taxi rank. We would be expecting the developers of the project to cover any costs. The licensing section will seek approval to investigate relocation of the spaces when required.

CREWKERNE - Somerfield

Due to the redevelopment of the site by Waitrose the current rank will need to be relocated. At the appropriate time, the licensing section will therefore seek approval (in conjunction with the Highways Department) to find a suitable relocation site in Crewkerne.
