Proposed Increase in the Number of Parish Councillors on Brympton Parish Council

Local Governance and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

South Somerset District Council has commenced a Community Governance Review in response to a request from Brympton Parish Council, requesting that the review should consider:

- Increasing the size of the Parish Council from 11 to 12 members

During September and October 2016, we asked for your views on this proposal. Although only a small number of responses were received all of them were in favour of the proposal.

Having taken into account the consultation responses made during the first stage of consultation, and having regard to the need to ensure that Community Governance within the area reflects the identities and interests of the Community, and is effective and convenient, the draft recommendation of officers is:

“To accept the vote from the people of Brympton and to agree to increase the number of Parish Councillors to twelve”.
