- If I am the only email please do not take this as an objection.
- The increase is long overdue, being around 15%.
- Perhaps you could then undertake a review and look at a much larger increase perhaps using rate 2 for rate 1, and increasing the other rate pro rata.
- Taking into account fuel prices almost doubling over the period, increases in living wage, inflation over the period and the current sharp rise of about 9%, as well as other increased cost.
- I would suggest drivers relying on the rank would be able to pay themselves very little and those sub contracting to form perhaps earning around 50% of living wage on a busy day.
